

Dance Arts Studio Dress Code

Ballet and Pointe

Students in Ballet I level and higher:

Black Leotard (any style)

White or Pink Tights, no tan

Pink Ballet Shoes

Hair must be in a **BUN** with all hair secured back and out of face.

Dance shorts and skirts are not permitted in your ballet class

Students in lower level ballet classes (Creative Movement and Primary Ballet) may wear any style and color of dancewear and tights.)

Jazz

All Jazz students:

Any color leotard

Your choice of black dance shorts w/tights or capris or jazz pants.

Black Jazz shoes

Tap

All tap students:

Any color leotard

Your choice of black dance shorts w/tights or capris or jazz pants.

Black tap shoes

Modern

All Modern Students:

Any color leotard

Your choice of black dance shorts or a short, transparent skirt.

White, pink or tan footless or conversion tights.

Tan foot undeez

HipHop

All HipHop Students:

Any color leotard

Your choice of black capris or dance pants. (Must be below your knees). **No baggy shorts.**

Black HipHop shoes.

Boys may wear shorts and a t-shirt.

We will no longer allow students to wear **tank tops** or **t-shirts** over their leotard.

Dance shorts must be **black** and anyone wearing booty shorts are required to wear tights.

No baggy gym shorts are allowed.

Students **MUST** come to class with their **hair pulled back** in a ponytail. Bangs must be bobby pinned out of their face. The office will no longer supply hairbands, the dancers **MUST COME PREPARED!!!**

Consequences: Teachers will begin keeping track when students are not dressed appropriately (including hair style) and after the third offense, students will be asked to sit out of class.
